Educational Background

Graduated with honors in Medicine from the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart in R ome, presenting a thesis on Echoendoscopy in subepithelial lesions of the gastrointestinal tr act, after having attended the Gastroenterology unit for 3 years and the Digestive Endosco py unit of the Gemelli Hospital for one year.
